In March, House Bill (HB) 166 was signed into law. This legislation requires the Ohio auditor of state to establish a fraud reporting system to handle reports of fraud within Ohio's public offices. In addition, it extends the whistle-blower protections found in Ohio Revised Code Section (RC) 124.341 to employees who file a fraud complaint with the auditor's office and places notification requirements on all public employers. *The new law requires that all employees be notified of the fraud reporting system:*

The State of Ohio has established a reporting system whereby public employees can file complaints of fraud and misuse of public funds by public offices or officials. Complaints can be made using any of the following methods:
