How to enroll in CCP:

- a. _____ Meet the requirements for “College Ready” as determined by the college.
 - **Minimum grade point average**
- b. _____ Complete the **“Intent to Participate in CCP” form** and turn it in at the UHS Guidance office by April 1 of every preceding year the student will participate in the CC+ program. (Forms must be turned in by March 10, 2021 to participate in CCP during the 2021-2022 school year.)
- c. _____ **Complete the college application for acceptance to the university/college by April 7 for YSU or April 17 for KSU** for the following school year. Applications will be completed at school on scheduled Application Days. **Students must be accepted to the college/university before they can choose to enroll for college credit/dual credit courses. Applying however does not require students to participate in CCP during the coming school year and students may decide not to participate without consequence.*
- d. _____ Complete course registration with YSU and/or KSU. *If your student earns a failing grade for any CCP course or withdrawals after the deadline, the student and/or parent/guardians will reimburse United Local Schools for the amount of funds paid to the college for the student.*

2. Advanced Placement courses taught by United Local HS teachers: (similar to CCP courses, to receive credit for AP courses, the students must pass an AP exam for the AP course they are taking). The AP Exam is an independent option for college credit and does not impact the student’s grade in the AP course.

3. CCP at Kent State Salem taught at Kent Salem Branch Campus by Kent State faculty:

Students who meet the college ready requirements listed above have the opportunity to take courses through Kent State University. Course offerings change each semester and students are advised at both UHS and Kent Salem. Credits earned through Kent State are applied to UHS graduation requirements. **NOTE:** Taking courses at KSU (off-site from UHS) could impact eligibility for Top Ten/Academic Honors, Honors Diploma, etc. based on those specific requirements. Students are responsible for transportation to and from campus, applying to the University, enrolling in classes and making appointments for advisement.

Youngstown State University minimum requirements:

- Minimum 3.0 cumulative high school gpa OR
- Minimum 2.0 gpa in core classes and minimum score on YSU Eligibility test

Deadline to apply: April 7, 2021 (YSU Application day @ UHS-March 18, 2021@ 8AM)

Kent State-Salem admission guidelines:

- Minimum 3.0 cumulative high school gpa

Deadline to apply: April 15, 2021 (Kent Application day @ UHS-March 16, 2021 @ 8AM)
